**ABLA PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO INTERVENE  
IN THE GAUTREAU LITIGATION**

NOW COME Movants, the Plaintiffs in Concerned Residents of ABLA v. Chicago Housing Authority et al., 99 C 4959, by and through their attorneys at the National Center on Poverty Law, Sonnenschein, Nath & Rosenthal, and the Chicago Lawyers Committee for Civil Rights Under Law, and respectfully request that this Court allow them to intervene in the Gautreaux litigation. In support of their Motion, the ABLA Plaintiffs state as follows:

1. ABLA Plaintiffs are entitled to intervene as a matter of right in this action pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 24(a)(2).
2. This motion to intervene is timely.
3. ABLA Plaintiffs possess an interest relating to the subject matter of this action.
4. ABLA Plaintiffs' interest will be impaired as a practical matter by Gautreaux's disposition.
5. ABLA Plaintiffs lack adequate representation of their interest by the existing parties in Gautreaux.

6. In the alternative, if this Court determines that ABLA Plaintiffs do not meet the requirements for intervention as of right, they respectfully request that this Court exercise its discretion to allow permissive intervention pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 24(b)(2).
7. ABLA Plaintiffs have claims that share a question of law or fact in common with this action.
8. Permissive intervention would not unduly delay or prejudice the adjudication of the rights of the original Gautreux parties.

**WHEREFORE**, Movants respectfully grant them intervention in Gautreux.
