

5. Pursuant to the parties' Mediation Stipulation, the petitioner has primary placement of the parties' minor children on a six-month trial basis beginning August 14, 1995 and to be reviewed in Mid-February 1996. During this trial placement, the petitioner's child support obligation, DVR requirement, and work search requirement is stayed. During this trial placement, neither party owes child support.

6. If the children are returned to the respondent prior to February of 1996 or at the February review, effective as of that date, petitioner's child support obligation, DVR requirement, and work search requirements are reinstated.

7. The petitioner's Motion for Vacation of the Judgment remains pending and is not affected by this Stipulation and Order.


