**STATEMENT OF UNDISPUTED ISSUES OF MATERIAL FACT**

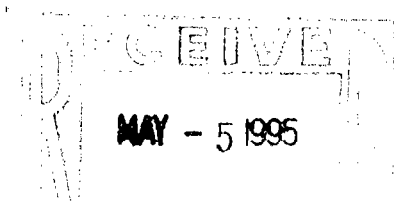
COMES NOW Defendant CREDIT BUREAU OF ATHENS, INC., (1<sup>t</sup>CBA<sup>1</sup>),

The subject employment location verification form does not contain any information in reference to collection of a debt owed by Steven Schmidt to St. Mary's Hospital. (Exhibit 1<sup>A</sup> to Plaintiff's Motion).
