**ORDER**

In it's Preliminary Injunction Order, the Court granted an injunction and specified that it take effect seven days from the date of entry. The Court directed the defendant to submit to the Court within seven (7) days an outline of how the defendant intends to implement the Court's Order with respect to three listed factors. The Court does not intend that Defendant at this time submit a detailed plan for implementing the injunction but merely an outline of the listed matters.


The Court has ordered that the injunctive relief take effect seven days from entry of the Order, by which the Court intends that on and after that date the Defendant will disregard federal SSI benefits paid to children through representative payees as household income for TANF eligibility consistent with the Preliminary Injunction Order. The Court does not intend that the change in policy be deferred.
