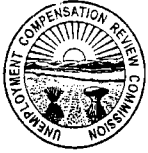

CASE HISTORY

On August 27, 2001, the claimant, [REDACTED] B, filed an Application for Determination of Benefit Rights. The application was allowed with a benefit year beginning August 26, 2001. The claimant filed a first claim for the week ending September 1, 2001.

A Determination of Benefits, issued September 21, 2001, held that the claimant was discharged by Englefield Oil Co., for just cause in connection with work. The claimant's benefit rights were suspended until the claimant works in six weeks of covered employment and earns at least \$1,014.00. The claim for the week ending September 1, 2001 was disallowed.

On October 4, 2001, the claimant filed an appeal from the Determination of Benefits. A Director's Redetermination, issued October 15, 2001, affirmed the determination.

On October 30, 2001, the claimant appealed the Director's Redetermination. On November 2, 2001, the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services transferred jurisdiction to the Unemployment Compensation Review Commission.

On January 29, 2002, a hearing was held in Cambridge, Ohio, before Hearing Officer Robert J. Wachunas. Claimant appeared at this hearing and was represented by Attorney Amy Gullifer.





The claimant was discharged by Englefield Oil Co., without just cause in connection with work. The suspension of benefits is removed. The claim for the week ending September 1, 2001 is allowed.

The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services will adjust charges to the account of Englefield Oil Co., in accordance -with this decision.

**APPEAL RIGHTS**

This decision is mailed on January 30, 2002.

A Request for Review before the U.C. Review Commission may be filed by any interested party within twenty-one calendar days after this decision is mailed. Said twenty-one day period is calculated to end on February 20, 2002.
