1 This Court entered default against Defendant Jerry Bloom, aka Tripper, D. Tripper, Dean
2 Tripper, Gerald Bloom, and Yassa Gadau individually and doing business as California Law
3 Clinic ("CLC") on April 4, 2005. Default having been entered and, upon request of Plaintiff
4 Legal Aid Foundation of Los Angeles ("LAFLA") to the Court, and after having considered the
5 evidence,

6 **IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:**

7 1) Defendant Jerry Bloom, aka Tripper, D. Tripper, Dean Tripper, Gerald Bloom, and
8 Yassa Gadau individually and doing business as California Law Clinic willfully infringed
9 Defendant's trademarks.

10 2) Defendant Jerry Bloom, aka Tripper, D. Tripper, Dean Tripper, Gerald Bloom, and
11 Yassa Gadau individually and doing business as California Law Clinic willfully engaged in false
12 advertising.

13 3) Defendant Jerry Bloom, aka Tripper, D. Tripper, Dean Tripper, Gerald Bloom, and
14 Yassa Gadau individually and doing business as California Law Clinic willfully engaged in
15 common law unfair competition.

16 4) Defendant Jerry Bloom, aka Tripper, D. Tripper, Dean Tripper, Gerald Bloom, and
17 Yassa Gadau individually and doing business as California Law Clinic engaged in statutory unfair
18 competition in violation of California Business and Professions Code §17200.

19 5) That Plaintiff LAFLA, by and through their attorneys, has judgment for costs of this
20 suit. That Defendant Jerry Bloom, aka Tripper, D. Tripper, Dean Tripper, Gerald Bloom, and
21 Yassa Gadau individually and doing business as California Law Clinic pay LAFLA the sum of
22 ~~\$4,059~~ _____ in costs.

23 6) That Plaintiff LAFLA, by and through their attorneys, has judgment for attorney
24 fees. That Defendant Jerry Bloom, aka Tripper, D. Tripper, Dean Tripper, Gerald Bloom, and
25 Yassa Gadau individually and doing business as California Law Clinic pay LAFLA the sum of
26 ~~\$100,000~~ _____ in attorney's fees.
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1 7) That Plaintiff LAFLA has judgment for damages for corrective advertising. That
2 Defendant Jerry Bloom, aka Tripper, D. Tripper, Dean Tripper, Gerald Bloom, and Yassa Gadau
3 individually and doing business as California Law Clinic pay LAFLA the sum of
4 ~~1\$500,000~~ _____ in damages for corrective advertising.

6 8) That Plaintiff LAFLA has judgment for damages for lost profits. That Defendant
7 Jerry Bloom, aka Tripper, D. Tripper, Dean Tripper, Gerald Bloom, and Yassa Gadau
8 individually and doing business as California Law Clinic pay LAFLA the sum of ~~1\$1,000,000~~
9 in damages for lost profits.

10 9) ~~That Plaintiff LAFLA has judgment for punitive damages for Defendant's~~
11 ~~fraudulent, oppressive and/or malicious conduct. That Defendant Jerry Bloom, aka Tripper, D.~~
12 ~~Tripper, Dean Tripper, Gerald Bloom, and Yassa Gadau individually and doing business as~~
13 ~~California Law Clinic pay LAFLA the sum of [1\$3,000,000] _____ in punitive~~

15 10) That Defendant Jerry Bloom, aka Tripper, D. Tripper, Dean Tripper, Gerald Bloom,
16 and Yassa Gadau individually and doing business as California Law Clinic, and his successors
17 and assigns, and officers, partners, employees, agents, representatives, and all persons acting or
18 claiming to act on their behalf or under their direction or authority and all persons acting in
19 concert or in participation with Defendant, who receive actual notice of this Order by personal
20 service, mail, facsimile, directly, or indirectly, by any means whatsoever, at any location, shall be
21 enjoined perpetually from each and all of the following:

22 A) using the name "LEGAL AID" or any other name, mark, or designation which is
23 a colorable imitation of, or is confusingly similar to, Plaintiff's LEGAL AID or
24 LEGAL AID FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES marks, including without
25 limitation all of the following designations:

LEGAL AID SOUTH BROADWAY;
LEGAL AID SANTA MONICA;
LEGAL AID CRENSHAW;
LEGAL AID COMPTON;
UNLAWFUL DETAINER;
TENANT LANDLORD DISPUTES;
RENTER'S RIGHTS A; and
EVICTION DEFENSE;

in connection with the advertising, distribution, offering for sale, or sale of goods and services in any field;

B) using any name, mark, or designation that contains the word "LEGAL," "LAW," "EVICTION," "BANKRUPTCY," "SMALL CLAIMS," "WORKER'S COMPENSATION," or "UNLAWFUL DETAINER" in any field;

C) advertising the sale of legal services or paralegal services by any means including, but not limited to, advertising over the Internet, through print media, by television, over the radio, in telephone books, by flyer or handouts, by billboard or sign, by word of mouth, by the use of cappers or runners, or through any other advertising channel;

D) providing legal services or paralegal services (including providing legal advice to others, discussing and advising others of legal strategies, filling out legal paperwork for others, or appearing on behalf of others in court or in administrative agency proceedings);

E) referring people to, or soliciting work on behalf of, lawyers, paralegals, or any legal service provider with the exception of LAFLA;

F) collecting, or attempting to collect, money from any person or organization to whom Defendant has provided legal or paralegal services; and

G) representing in any manner or by any method whatsoever, that goods, services, or

1 other products provided by Defendant is sponsored, approved, authorized by or
2 originate from LAFLA, or otherwise taking any action likely to cause confusion,
3 mistake or deception as to the origin, approval, sponsorship, or certification of such
4 goods or services.

6 11) Defendant shall provide to LAFLA all ownership and control over all of its business
7 telephone numbers including all of the following:

12 213-741-0456;

15 800-959-6625.

16 Entry of this **DEFAULT JUDGMENT AND PERMANENT INJUNCTION** is
17 sufficient authority for any telephone service provider to deliver all ownership and control

19 12) Defendant shall deliver up to LAFLA for destruction any and all products,
20 containers, packages, labels, literature, catalogs, signs, promotional material and the like bearing
21 the designation LEGAL AID or any name confusingly similar to LEGAL AID or LEGAL AID
22 FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES.

23 13) Defendant shall send written notification to all their customers, clients, vendors, and
24 associates advising them of this Judgment.

25 14) Defendant shall immediately cease operations at all of its Internet sites and e-mail
26 addresses related to its law clinic, including the site located at

28 lawclinic@earthlink.net.

15) Defendant shall place signs at all of its locations including its location at 1057 and
