




1 The Court having considered the Motion for Final Approval of Settlement and supporting  
2 papers, other papers submitted in connection with the motion, the oral presentations at the hearing  
3 on the motion, and the other papers of record in this action; good cause appearing,

4 The Court finds that the terms of the settlement as set forth in the moving papers are not  
5 the product of fraud or overreaching by, or collusion between, the negotiating parties, and that the  
6 settlement, taken as a whole, is fair, reasonable, and adequate. Good cause appearing,

7 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that final approval of the settlement is GRANTED.

8 If any party to the settlement fails to take the actions it has agreed to take upon the grant  
9 of this order of final approval, that failure may be brought to the attention of the Court by motion  
10 for an order specifically enforcing the Settlement Implementation Agreement.
