YOUR SNAP BENEFITS ARE GETTING A BOOST:

ALL SNAP RECIPIENTS WILL RECEIVE AN ADDITIONAL 15% IN SNAP BENEFITS FROM JANUARY TO JUNE

Beginning in January 2021, all SNAP recipients will receive a **15% increase** to their benefits for January through June of 2021.

If you are currently approved for <u>less</u> than the maximum benefit amount for your household size, you may <u>also</u> continue to receive emergency allotments. These allotments will bring you up to the maximum benefit amount for your household size. You will receive them for as long as there is an emergency declaration in place for the COVID-19 pandemic.

Below is a chart of the maximum benefit amount for each household size and the maximum amount with the additional 15% increase.

SNAP recipients will receive benefits in **two separate payments** each month:

- First payment: your regular monthly benefits plus 15%
- Second payment: an emergency allotment bringing you up to the maximum benefit for your household size
